

WEAPONS CATEGORY

A

a) Weapons

1. Military, including firing equipment, exception of rifles, pistols and revolvers, certified for civilian use, if they are a subject to verification according to special law;
2. Self-acting,
3. Made or modified so that it can hide its function, or for which the original character and shape changed so, that their use can cause a heavier consequences, or disguised as other objects (insidious weapons);
4. Firearms, not manufactured from metals, if they aren't identifiable as weapons at passengers and luggage checking due to detection and X-ray devices;
5. Gas or expansion weapons, if doesn't go about allowed production design;
6. Shooting-trap devices and
7. With firmly inbuilt silencer of shot noise or with firmly inbuilt laser sighting device.

b) Ammunition

1. With penetrating explosive or inflammable shot;
2. For rifles with short shock shot or a shot designed to increase the wounded effect;
3. Ammunition which doesn't be responsible with production design and
4. Munitions.

c) Weapons accessory

1. Silencers of shot noise
2. Weapon sighting devices, designed on principle of night vision equipment
3. Laser sighting devices.
